



## Investigating Optical Correction History and Meridional Amblyopia in Adults with Astigmatism

The study might be a good fit for you if:

- Are aged 18-25 years
- Have no or low levels of astigmatism (maximum of 0.50DC) as controls
- Or have moderate levels of astigmatism (at least 1.50DC) for the Astigmatic group

### What would happen if I took part in the research project?

If you decide to take part you would:

- The study will involve evaluation of your visual acuity at different orientations and requires 2 hours of your time.

You may be reimbursed in the form of a voucher for any reasonable travel, parking, meals and other expenses associated with the research project visit/s.
